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## **SHAC Minutes for September 2, 2015 Meeting**

The Lohn ISD SHAC met on September 2, 2015 in the school cafeteria to discuss the 2015-2016 Lohn ISD Wellness Policy and Program. Voting members present were Steve Coston, Michelle Horne, and William Sneed. Advisory members present were Alfie Sneed and Paige Martin. Meeting was called to order at 3:00 pm by Steve Coston.

Minutes of the May 20, 2015 minutes were read and approved.

Mr. Coston reported that he is still looking into the changes the committee wanted to see amended in the program implementation for the 2015-2016 school year.

Mrs. Sneed reported that she was notified that Lohn ISD would be having a cafeteria compliance audit this school year, but that she did not know the date at this time. She and Mr. Coston would be attending training in the near future and would notify the committee if anything was needed from them for this audit.

Mrs. Sneed also reported that TASB was going to be making some changes to what the wellness policy was to contain, but has not made the changes at this time. She also reported that she has asked Mr. Freeman and Mr. Coston for assistance in seeing that all staff was trained in Civil Rights Training this school year in case they are needed in the cafeteria. The cafeteria will continue to use the 6 week cycle menu for this school year and she was trying to get her food vendor to be more responsive to her needs.

Mr. Martin reported that he was excited about being here and would like to get the students involved in Jump Rope for Hearts this year. He would like to revamp the physical education program for the students to involve more programs and activities. He also reported that he has been given permission to purchase some new physical education equipment for his program.

Mr. Coston reported that he is trying to contact the Lake Brownwood Lion's Club to continue their program of coming to check our students' hearing and vision, but has not had any success yet. Mrs. Sneed reminded Mr. Coston that our students needed education in personal hygiene and sexual awareness. Mr. Coston said he was checking into that as well. Mrs. Horne volunteered to talk to the students if needed.
